PAYMENT or PREPAYMENT OPTIONS

- Students may continue to pay with cash daily at any register.
- Prepayment by cash or check can be taken at any register.
 - Please include the student's name and grade on the envelope or check.
- Checks are to be made payable to **Quabbin Regional School District.**
- Student accounts can be paid or prepaid online through mySchoolBucks.com.
 - A link to MySchoolBucks.com, our on-line payment system is located under the Food Service tab on the district's main webpage.
 - Payments may be made using an e-check or credit card.
 - Payments may be made at any time, in any amount.
 - There is a \$1.95 service charge when using this method.
 - The Quabbin Regional School District does not receive the service charge.
 - Account balances at the end of the school year can be:
 - Requested, in writing, to be refunded
 - Remain on account for next school year, or
 - In the case of a senior graduating, transferred into a sibling's account for next school year
- Prices: Elementary: Breakfast - \$1.75 Reduced breakfast - \$0.30
 Lunch - \$2.75 Reduced lunch - \$0.40

 Middle/High: Breakfast - \$2.00 Reduced breakfast - \$.030
 Lunch - \$3.00 Reduced lunch - \$0.40

Benefits for Parents/Guardians and Students

- When an account is prepaid, parents/guardians can be sure that the student is using that money for breakfast or lunch items served in our cafeteria.
- Prepaid accounts allow parents the convenience to deposit money in their student's account, in any amount, at any time.
- Prepaying meals lead to shorter, quicker lines.
- PIN pads are located at every register and allow for quick transactions.
- Prepayment allows for better security than cash.
- The student will know his/her account balance at the end of each transaction.
- When a student's account balance gets low, students will be informed at the register.
- Free or reduced meals confidentiality is assured.
- Students may use any register.
- Parents/guardians can setup automatic emails for low balance alerts.
