Cancellation Penalties

If an individual needs to cancel, the following penalty will apply based on the date that the cancellation is received in writing to the school office.

Now	to	Dec 31, 2019	-	\$200.00 Penalty Per Person
Jan 1, 2020	to	Feb 15, 2020	-	\$350.00 Penalty Per Person
Feb 16, 2020	to	Apr 11, 2020	-	Full Amount Paid Penalty

- **If a student moves out of district, the refund amount will follow the schedule above.**
- **If a student is removed from the trip by administration, the refund amount will follow the schedule above. (Please see the reminder note below).**

Optional Cancellation Insurance

Optional cancellation insurance is available to individual students at an additional cost. This would allow for a full refund of the amount paid for the trip if the individual needed to cancel due to a covered medical reason. Further details about this insurance are available upon request.

Reminder

Important excerpt from the student handbook (page 18):

Field trips are scheduled throughout the school year. These opportunities are designed to support different aspects of the classroom curriculum, to reward accomplishments, and to introduce students to the resources of the region. Parents will receive notices of field trips in advance of the scheduled trip date and will be asked to sign field trip permission forms.

All middle school field trips and extra-curricular activities are an additional privilege beyond the basic educational program. Any student may be excluded from field trips or other school activities at the discretion of the administration. Reasons for exclusion may include, but are not limited to, repeated or severe disciplinary infractions, excessive absenteeism and/or poor academic performance. Students may be excluded from field trips and/or other activities if the administration determines that participation may be detrimental to the student and/or others.
